

## St Giles Juniors Canterbury



The King's School has a history dating back to 597 AD, making it the oldest site on which a school has been located in England.

Modern accommodation, teaching, and recreational facilities combined with the medieval school buildings and grounds offer a magical experience. Lessons take place in the grounds of Canterbury Cathedral, whilst the residential accommodation is on the St Augustine's Abbey site, just a five minute walk away.

Our Canterbury centre offers a traditional English boarding school experience to older students, whilst also providing additional levels of supervision and care for younger students. The school's recreation centre is a short distance away, boasting excellent sports facilities which our students use regularly. Our English Plus Sport Options take place here on two afternoons per week and offer students the chance to receive tuition from experienced coaches to improve their techniques and skills.

### Classes & Meals

Classes take place in the Cathedral grounds at The King's School, a five minute walk from the St. Augustine's Site. Meals are taken on-site in one of the school's dining rooms, except on excursion days when a packed lunch or meal ticket is provided.

### Activities & Excursions

A full afternoon and evening activity programme is provided. There are a range of activities per week including discos, film nights, karaoke, talent shows, football and bowling.

There will also be at least two full-day and two half-day excursions per week included in the package price. Destinations include London, Hastings, and Brighton Beach.
